It is with great sadness that I inform you of the sudden death of Vincent Jacquet, Director of International Relations, Development and the World Cycling Centre.

The UCI expresses its deepest condolences to his wife and children, faced with the loss of a loved one.

Vincent dedicated his life to sport and fully understood its positive power on society. Since 2019, Vincent had been a central figure at the UCI, unanimously appreciated both by our Federations and by all the stakeholders with whom he was in contact. He was known and recognised by all, and admired for his professionalism and his human qualities. He also headed the UCI World Cycling Centre, which he developed into a reference point and model for the entire cycling family, as well as for the Olympic movement.

Vincent was one of my faithful colleagues for many years, firstly at the Fédération Française de Cyclisme (FFC) before joining me at the UCI. I had total confidence in Vincent and I always saw him working hard for the sport he loved so much. We are losing a colleague, but also a friend, who defended the future of the sport, of our sport.
